

Tools Required

Adjustable Wrench Groove Joint Pliers Pipe Wrench Phillips Screwdriver Pipe Tape or Pipe Thread Compound 1/2" iron pipe plug

Safety Tips

If you solder the joints during installation of the faucet, the seats, cartridges, and washers must be removed before using a flame or the warranty will be voided on these parts.

Protect your eyes with safety glasses when cutting or soldering water supply lines.

Cover the sink drain to avoid losing parts.

Things You May Need

Installations may vary depending on how the previous faucet was installed. Supplies necessary for the installation of your faucet are not all included; however, they are available wherever plumbing supplies are sold.

Maintenance

Your new trim kit is designed for years of trouble-free performance.

Keep it looking new by cleaning it periodically with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool, and harsh chemicals as these will dull the finish and void your warranty.

Important Points

Prior to beginning installation, turn off the hot and cold water lines, then turn on the old faucet to release built-up pressure. When installing your new faucet, turn the connector nuts finger tight, then use one wrench to hold the fitting and a second wrench to tighten the nut. Connections that are too tight will reduce the integrity of the system.

Wrap all threaded connections with PTFE pipe tape available at your local hardware or plumbing supply store. Always wrap in a clock-wise direction.







PRESSURE TESTING: Install a 1/2" iron pipe plug (not included) on both shower and tub outlets. Turn hot and cold valve stems to full "on" position and check connections for leaks. Turn stem to "OFF". Slowly remove pipe plugs from shower and tub outlets.



Before installing escutcheon, remove the plastic cap from plaster guard by twisting cap clockwise.



After wall treatment, install escutcheon onto valve then screw in escutcheon and install handle assembly.

Troubleshooting

PROBLEM: Leaks from under handle
CAUSE: Bonnet is loose or bottom gasket on cartridge is dirty or twisted.
ACTION:
Remove faucet handle. Tighten the bonnet. Clean or replace O-ring.


