



Craftmade Fan Blades

Craftmade Brands classifies its fan blades into six types. There is Type 1 through Type 5 fan blades and also “Specialty” fan blades. The blade types are organized by blade hole pattern, weight and style. Blades are designed to specifically fit certain fan motors. You can also see differences in the types by the features of the blades. The ‘custom carved’ blades in the Type 1 group are more expensive than other models, but the blades can be paired with a more basic motor and create a classier ceiling fan overall.

For each type of blade, you will find several blade models that fall under that classification. This means Craftmade ceiling fans that use Type 1 blades will have several blade models that will fit that ceiling fan. Craftmade truly gives you the option to customize your ceiling fan with so many blades and finishes to choose from.

Below you will find a breakdown of which blade models are classified under what types. We have listed the base models for the fan blades; copy and paste any of these into our search bar and you will be directed to the fan blade product page. These blades are compatible for Craftmade and Ellington ceiling fans.
